That the complainant and respondent have entered into an agreement with reference to the custody, control, support and maintenance of the said minor child, a copy of which is hereto attached as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof, and by the terms of which agreement, your complainant is to have the complete care, control, custody, support and maintenance of said child.

Complainant avers that he is a fit and proper person to have custody and control of said minor child and that said agreement is a reasonable, just and proper agreement and prays the court that in the event a decree of divorce is given in this cause that the Court will decree that the parties keep and abide by the terms of said agreement.

The premises considered, your complainant makes the said Grace E. Walker a party respondent to this bill of complaint and in order that complainant may have the relief herein prayed for, may it please your Honor to cause the State's writ of subpoena to be issued, directed to the said Grace E. Walker, commnading her to answer, plead or demur to this bill of complaint within the time required by law; and that on a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will enter a decree divorcing your complainant form the respondent; and that your Honor will grant such other, further or different releif as unto your Honor may seem just and propertand your complainant will ever pray.

THIS AGREEMENT made and enterediinto on this the day of September, 1957 by and between LEROY WALKER, herein after referred to as the party of the first part and GRACE E. WALKER, hereinafter refrred to as the party of the second part.

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the parties hereto have been husband and wife since June 11, 1956, and as a result of such marriage have one minor child. Kathleen Marie Walker, five months of age, and.

Whereas, the parties hereto have separated and ahve been living apart for over a year and have definitely concluded that it is impractical for them to live together as husband and wife, and

Whereas, the party of the first part is contemplating bringing an action for divorce and it is the desire of the parties to settle the matter of the care, control, support and maintenance of said minor child of the marriage without litagation,

NOW, THEREFOR, in consideration thereof, and of the mutual agreemtns hereinafter made, they have mutually agreed to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. That the party of the first part, the father of said minor child, shall have the complete care, control, custody, support and maintenance of the said minor child.
- 2. Thet the party of the second part the mother of said child, shall have the right to see and visit with said minor child at all reasonable times and places and shall also, at such times and places as the complainant may in his descretion designate, have said child visit with her.
- 3. That in the event the party of the first part insists on his express determination to file a suit for a divorce, it shall be thoroughly understood that the party of the second part denies and expects to continue to demy that the party of the first part is in anyway entitled to a divorce, and in the event that the Court, upon hearing should decide that the party of the first part is entitled to a divorce, then it is agreed that this agrreement and all of its terms shall be submitted to the Court for its approval and shall not be executed until and unless the Court does approve the same.

This agreement is made and executed in good faith on the day and date hereinabove set forth, with full understanding of all of its provisions, and with the mutual promise on the part of each to comply therewith completely and faithfully.
