That Earl Edward Hobbs is over the age of twenty-one years, and is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. That the Complainant and Respondent were lawfully married on, to-wit, October 3, 1956. There were no children of this marriage.

3. Complainant further avers that the Respondent has committed actual physical violence on her person attended with danger to her life and health; by striking her with his fists, and from his conduct toward her, she is reasonably apprehensive of other and further violence, so much so that she can no longer live with the Respondent; That the Respondent has made numerous threats of doing her other and further physical harm, and from his manner and conduct toward her she is reasonably convinced that he will commit actual violence on her person attended with danger to her life or health.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Your Complainant prays that Earl Edward Hobbs be made a party defendant of this cause by the usual process of this Honorable Court, requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause that she be granted a divorce from the said Earl Edward Hobbs. Should

your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that she be granted such other, further, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Pollie F. Hobbs the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

My name is Shirley A. Satterfield. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. I am personally acquainted with Pollie F. Hobbs and Earl Edward Hobbs. They were married October 3, 1956, and lived together as husband and wife until approximately one week ago, at which time he struck her with his fists and threatened to choke her, and to do other physical harm to her, and from his conduct and manner toward her, I feel that she should be afraid to live with him, and feel that it is reasonable for her to be afraid of him. There were no children of this marriage, Both Pollie F. Hobbs and Earl Edward Hobbs are over twenty-one years of age, and are resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama, Pollie F. Hobbs having lived in Baldwin County, Alabama for over twenty years.
