1. That her name is Madra Elizabeth Hammock and she is one and the same person as the Complainant in that certain cause heretofore pending in this Court wherein Robert T. Hammock was the Respondent and in which cause this Honorable Court granted to her a divorce from the said Robert T. Hammock and in and by the terms of said decree awarded to her the full and complete custody and control of Robert T. Hammock, Jr. and Debora Kaye Hammock, minor children of the undersigned Madra Elizabeth Hammock and the said Robert T. Hammock; and that in and by the terms of said decree this Honorable Court further ordered the said Robert T. Hammock to pay to her for the use and benefit of said minor children for their maintenance and support and education the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) each two week period beginning Monday, October 14, 1957, and each two weeks thereafter until further ordered by this Court. 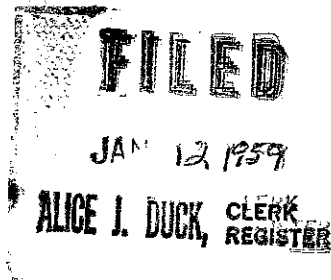

Further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the Complainant Madra Elizabeth Hammock be, and she hereby is, awarded


