ROBERTS, JR., is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that he has no legal guardian; that he is over the age of twenty years and under the age of twenty-one years; that a copy of the petition of FELTON J. ROBERTS, SR., for the removal of the disabilities of the said FELTON J. ROBERTS, JR., has been served upon the said FELTON J. IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Petitioner pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
