- -1. That he is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. That the lands here in controversy are situated in Bald-win County, Alabama and are more particularly described as follows:

- 3. He alleges and avers that he obtained said property and title thereto by two conveyances; one from Anatasia Weeks and husband C. S. Weeks, a Warranty Deed dated December 9, 1941 and recorded in Deed Book 76 NS page 493, records in the Office of the Judge of Pro bate of Baldwin County, Alabama and conveying lot number six of the Louis Collins'division of the Alexander Baudan and Catalina Plock Grants; the other from Clementine Weeks by the State Land Commissioner, a tax deed dated August 18, 1943 and recorded September 22, 1943 in Deed Book 80 NS page 460 in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and said complainant immediately entered into actual peaceable possession said lands upon the executionoof said conveyances; that the complainant has remained in actual peaceable possession since then of said lands.
- 4. That the complainant has regularly assessed said lands in the office of the Tax Assessor of Ealdwin County, Alabama without exception; that the complainant has regularly paid the taxes thereon.
- 5. That no one except your complainant has paid taxes on said lands within ten years next preceding the filing of this bill except W. G. Weeks who purchased said lands at a void or voidable tax sale for 1947 taxes, subsequent to which your complainant has been the only person to assessed pay taxes on said lands.
- 6. Complainant represents and states that hedoes not know of any-one, persons or corporations, who or that claim said lands, any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance thereon or any part thereof, except W. G. Weeks, who has obtained a tax deed from the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County for said lands, which deed is recoreded in Deed Book 173 page 236 and is a void or voidable deed. Complainant avers that he has exercised diligence in trying to ascertain the names of any person or corporation who claim said lands or any interest therein. He has obtained an abstract which shows that the only posible claimants according to said abstract other than W. G. Weeks, Are: The Farmers and Merchants Bank, a Corporation whose address is Foley, Alabama; which corporation held a mortgage on said property dated April 7, 1942 and recorded in

mortgage book 93 page 494 and the complainant further avers said mortgage has been fully satisfied but not cancelled of record; Sarah La Coste and Frost Sibley Lumber Company, who through error on the Plat Books in the Tax Assessor's Office of Baldwin County showing the said Sarah La Coste and Frost Sibley Lumber Company assessing part of the land in controversy, are reputed to own or have an interest in said lands; and the heirs of Clemantina Weeks, if deceased.

7. Complainant further avers that there is no suit pending to test his interest in or title to or possession of said lands.

The premises considered, coplainant files this his verified bill of complaint against W. G. Weeks, Clemantina Weeks or her Heirs if deceased, Sarah La Coste, Frost Sibley Lumber Company, The Farmers and Merchants Bank of Foley, Alabama, a Corporation, and against the said lands and against any and all persons or corporations claiming any title thereto, interest in, lien or encumbrance upon said lands or any part thereof and to establish the right or title to said land and to clear up all doubts or disputes concerning the same and that the parties herin above named shall be made respondents to this bill of complainant and that process be served on them or publication be made requiring them to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time required by law or decree pro confesso may be entered against them, and pray that this court will make and enter all orders, judgements and decrees that may be meet and proper in the premises and that upon a final hearing of this cause will decree that complainant, William H. Baker is the owner and has a fee simple title to the lands in controversy, free from all liens and encumbrances, and will grant the complainant such other, further or different relief as it may appear to the court to be just and equitable.
