Comes your complainant, Winberg Orchards and Nurseries
Company, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State
of Alabama, and presents this, its bill of complaint against the
following described lands in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter
of the Northwest quarter of Section 26, Township
5 South, Range 3 East;

and against the unknown heirs, devisees and personal representatives
of Edgar B. Fisher, deceased, and against any and all persons, firms,
corporations or associations, claiming any title to, interest in,
claim, lien or encumbrances on said lands or any part or parcel
thereof and respectfully shows unto your honor:

FIRST: That complainant is an Alabama Corporation, its
principal place of business being, Silverhill, Baldwin County,
Alabama, that Edgar B. Fisher is dead, that he died more than 15
years ago, that during his life he resided in Chicago, Illinois,
that complainant has made diligent search to ascertain the names
and places of residence of the heirs, devisees and personal repre-
sentatives of Edgar B. Fisher, deceased; that it has inquired of

numerous persons in the vicinity in which such land is located, and of persons in Chicago, Illinois, who knew said Edgar B. Fisher, and has searched the records of Baldwin County, and upon such inquiry has been unable to ascertain their names, ages and post office addresses, but is informed and believes and upon such information and belief alleges that the heirs, devisees and personal representatives of the said Edgar B. Fisher, deceased are over the age of twenty-one years and are non-residents of the State of Alabama, their place of residence being unknown to complainant, and cannot be ascertained.

SECOND: That your complainant is the owner of in fee simple and in the actual possession of the said lands in Baldwin County, Alabama, described as follows, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 5 South, Range 3 East in Baldwin County, Alabama;

that it and those through whom it claims have been in the continuous peaceable adverse possession of the said lands for more than ten years next preceding the filing of this complaint and that it and those through whom it claims title to the said lands have for more than ten years next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint annually assessed and paid the taxes on the said lands and that during such period of time no other person has assessed the said lands for taxes or paid taxes thereon, and that no other person for such period has had, or attempted to exercise any possession over the said land or claimed any right to possession thereof or any title to, or interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance thereon, or to any part or parcel of the same.

THIRD: That no suit is pending to test complainant's title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on, or right of possession of said land.

FOURTH: That the complainant holds title to the aforesaid lands by purchase from Edgar B. Fisher in the summer of 1931, and the said Edgar B. Fisher executed and delivered to this complainant a good and sufficient deed conveying to it the said lands,

which said deed has been lost and cannot be found; that Edgar B. Fisher acquired title to the said lands by mesne conveyances from the United States Government; that your complainant immediately upon his purchase of the said lands went into possession of the same, claiming to own the same, and has continuously each year commencing with the year 1931 had the said land under fence and in cultivation, and that it has been in the actual, peaceable, continuous and adverse possession of the same for more than twenty years next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint and has annually assessed and paid taxes on the said lands for more than ten years next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint.

WHEREFORE, your complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and by appropriate process make the said unknown heirs, devisees and personal representatives of the said Edgar B. Fisher, deceased, and all other persons, firms, associations or corporations claiming any title to, or interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance upon the said lands, to-wit: The Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 5 South, Range 3 East, in Baldwin County, Alabama, or any part or parcel thereof, to be made parties defendant to this bill of complaint and by appropriate process require them and each of them separately and severally to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree ascertaining and decreeing that the fee simple title, free of liens, claims and encumbrances to the said lands and each part and parcel thereof, is vested in your complainant, Winberg Orchards & Nurseries Company, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Alabama, as against the unknown heirs, devisees and personal representatives of Edgar B. Fisher, and as against any and all persons firms, associations, corporations, claiming any title to, interest in, claim, lien encumbrance upon said lands or any part thereof,

and that any and all doubts and disputes concerning the same be cleared up, and your complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as in equity and good conscience shall seem meet and proper.






