Your complainant Myrtle B. Nelson, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor:

1. That the complainant is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of said State And County, and has been a bona-fide resident for more than two years next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint; that George W. Nelson is over the age of twenty-one years and resides in Bon Secour, Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. That your complainant and respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, October 30, 1930, at Mobile, Alabama; that of this marriage there are two minor children dependant upon said complainant and respondent, namely, Leslie Howard Nelson, age 15 years and Vernon Lee Nelson, age six years.

3. Your Complainant avers and charges that the said respondent did on or about, to-wit, July 1, 1952, and many times subsequent thereto assault beat, hit and strike the complainant; that said respondent has committed actual violence on her person attended with danger to her life and health; ~~Complainant avers and charges that respondent has made numerous threats of doing her physical harm and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit an actual violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life or health.~~

4. Your complainant further avers and alleges that the said respondent has, since her said marriage to him, become addicted to habitual drunkenness, and that said habit has continued to the filing of this bill.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your complainant makes the said George W. Nelson a party respondent to this bill of complaint, and in order that complainant may have the relief herein prayed for, may it please your Honor to cause the State's Writ of Subpoena to be issued, directed to the said George W. Nelson, commanding him to answer, plead or demur to this bill of complaint, within the time required by law; and that on a final hearing of this cause, that your honor will enter a decree divorcing your complainant from said respondent, granting the complainant the custody and control of the two said dependant children and a reasonable sum of money to be paid weekly by the respondent for the support and maintenance of the two said children and granting a reasonable attorney's fee for the complainant's attorney in this cause; and that your Honor will grant such other, further or different relief as unto your Honor may seem just and proper, and your complainant will ever pray.
