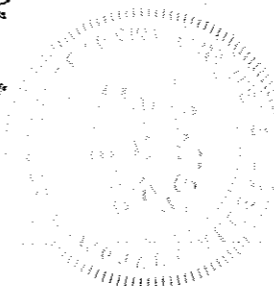

SECOND:


That the said Martha Dyess is the mother of Joseph Ezra Dyess,

conditionally from the disabilities of non-age and that the said
Joseph Ezra Dyess be vested with the right to sell and convey real
estate, to contract, to sue and be sued and in general, to do and per-
form such acts which said minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-
one years of age.

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for final decree on the Petition of Martha Dyess, the mother of Joseph Ezra Dyess, the order setting the day for the hearing of said petition, the notice to Joseph Ezra Dyess, the affidavits of K. B. Bush and E. B. Biggs, all as noted by the Register.

And the court having considered the same and it appearing to the court that it would be to the best interest of said minor if he were relieved of the disabilities of non-age, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Petition of Martha Dyess be, in all things allowed, and that Joseph Ezra Dyess be and he hereby is relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and is vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy to sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all the acts which he would lawfully do if he were of the full age of twenty-one years.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Joseph Ezra Dyess file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and a certified copy hereof in the Office of the Probate Judge of each other County in this State in which he may hereafter reside, or in which he may do any business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Martha Dyess pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
