It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Jesse Fred Parker the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

Your Complainant further avers and alleges that said Respondent has been guilty of adultery with divers parties and persons whose names to your complainant are unknown.



have called and caused to come before me Jesse Fred Parker and Lillie Mae Parker

witnesses named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 1952, at the office of C. LeNoir Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness es to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Jesse Fred Parker and Lillie Mae Parker doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Jesse Fred Parker, that I am over the age of 19 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been more than two years next preceding, and the Respondent is over the age of 18 and also a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been more than two years next preceding. We were married the 29th day of April, 1952 in Harrison County, Mississippi, and lived as husband and wife until May 4, 1952, at which time we were separated that on or about the 8th day of September, 1952 the Respondent was guilty of adulter with an enlisted member of the U. S. Naval Force, whose name is unknown to the petitioner, but the Respondent and the Service man were arrested by the Marshall at Foley, Alabama, and a Deputy Sheriff of Baldwin County, and placed in the Baldwin County jail on the night of September 11, 1952 charged with the offence of adultery.

We have not lived together since our separation and there were no children born as fruits of this marriage, and there is no property to be divided. I would like my divorce because I know we will never live together again as husband and wife.

That my name is Lillie Mae Parker I know both parties to this cause they were married April 29, 1952 at Gulf Port, Mississippi, and lived together as husband and wife until about May 4, 1952 at which time they separated, since their separation the Respondent in this cause was arrested by Foley, Alabama and Baldwin County, Alabama officers in company with an enlisted member of the U. S. Navy and they were charged with adultery and placed in the Baldwin County jail where the Respondent is now held. The Respondent and the Complainant have not lived together as husband and wife since their separation and I do not believe they will ever live together as husband and wife again. There were no children born of this marriage and there is no property to be divided.
