

Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Frank J. Dusek Jr. and Paul Haupt Jr. doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Frank J. Dusek Jr. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, living at Lillian and over twenty-one years of age. The Respondents named in the bill of complaint are all over twenty-one years of age, and non-residents of the State of Alabama, and their last known addresses are as given in the bill of complaint.

I am the owner in fee simple and in the actual possession of the land described in the bill of complaint in Baldwin County, Alabama, and being Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section 21, Township 7 South, Range 6 East. There is no suit pending to test my title to, interest in or rights of possession to said land. I acquired title to the said land by conveyance from Joseph R. Dusek and wife Dated February 12, 1942. Joseph R. Dusek, prior to the date he executed the deed to me, had been in possession of and paying the taxes on the said land for a number of years, and immediately after acquiring title to the said land I went into the actual possession thereof and have been continuously to this time; that during the said time no person, firm or corporation has exercised or attempted to exercise any rights of possession to or any right, title or interest in and to the said lands adversely to Joseph R. Dusek and me. The title to said lands stand upon the records of Baldwin County, Alabama, in my name, and no one has at any time within ten years next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause paid any taxes upon said land other than Frank J. Dusek Jr. and Joseph R. Dusek in the name of Teresa Krivacsy. The only persons shown by the records of Baldwin County, Alabama, to claim said lands or any interest therein are Frank J. Dusek Jr., and Teresa Krivacsy.

I have made and caused to be made a diligent search and inquiry to find out the addresses of the parties named as Respondents, inquiring of parties in and around Lillian, the vicinity in which said land is located, and examining the tax and land books and probate records of Baldwin County at Bay Minette, Alabama; that from and as a result of said search and inquiry the names of the Respondents are as given in the bill of complaint; that all are over twenty-one years of age and non-residents of the State of Alabama, if living and if dead their heirs are all non-residents of the State of Alabama.

Cross-examination by guardian ad litem:

All or a greater part of the land is under fence and in cultivation, and a house thereon. I have together with Joseph R. Dusek from whom I purchased the land, been in possession of the said land, cultivating the same since acquiring title thereto and that prior to that time, for a number of years Joseph R. I have had occasion to see the land most every day or at least once or twice each week and no person has claimed any rights or possession or any right, title, or interest in said land for more than ten years next preceding to the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause.
