- 5. That the said land which is the subject of this suit is located in Baldwin County being more particularly described as follows:

Lot Three (3) in Block Four (4) and same being in the Incorporated Town of Robertsdale, Baldwin County, Alabama, Section 6, Township 6 South and Range 4 East.
