NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration thereof, and of the mutual agreements hereinafter made, they have mutually agreed to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The party of the second part shall have the specific right to have the children visit with him for one day out of the week twice each month which will not be accumalative. The children will be returned to the party of the first part at her residence before Eight O'Clock p.m..
- 2. The party of the Second part shall pay to the party of the First part the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month on or before the third day of each month for the support and maintenance of the said minor children, beginning immedietly.
- 3. That in the event the party of the first part insists on her express determination to file suit for divorce against the party of the second part, it shall be thoroughly understood that the party of the Second part denies and expects to continue to deny that the party of the first part is in anyway entitled to a divorce, and in the event that he Court, upon hearing should decide that the party of the First part is entitled to a divorce, then it is agreed and understood that this agreement and all of its terms shall be submitted to the Court for its approval and shall not be executed until and unless the Court does approve the same.

This agreement has been made and executed by the parties hereto in good faith on the day and date hereinabove set forth, with full understanding of all its provisions, and with the mutual promise on the part of each to comply therewith faithfully and completely.


