

ANSWER OF NANCY PACKER

Comes the Respondent, NANCY PACKER, and in answer to the Bill of Complaint filed against her says:

- 1. Respondent admits that she is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Point Clear, Baldwin County, Alabama, but has no knowledge of the other facts alleged in said paragraph.
- 2. Respondent denies the allegations in paragraph 2, and says that she claims to own said property.
- 3. Respondent denies the allegations in paragraph 3, and says that she claims to own all of said property, claiming a one-half interest in said property by a deed from MRS. R. P. HENRIES, conveying the property to herself, and her deceased husband, ED PACKER, and she claims her one-half interest in her own right and the other one-half interest as the widow of said deceased, ED PACKER.
- 4. Respondent admits that there is no suit pending regarding the title to the possession of said property, and admits that there is a dwelling house situated on said property, but claims her one-half interest in her own right and the one-half interest belonging to her deceased husband, as his widow.
- 5. In further answer to Complainant's bill, Respondent shows that she is in possession of said property, claiming to own same as the widow of the said ED PACKER, and has in good faith and without any intention of embarrassing the co-tenants, or hindering petition, or gaining an advantage thereby, improved said property, paid taxes on same, where the co-tenants have neglected their claim thereto; and that this Respondent spent large sums of money in re-

6. 

All of the respondents are over the age of twenty-one years and their places of residence are as follows: Martha Packer, 40 Carson Drive, Fort Walton, Florida; Ed Packer, Jr., 354 Humter Street, Ossining, New York; Tom Packer, 844 West Deleware Street, Tallahassee, Florida; Nancy Packer, Point Clear, Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. Complainant further shows unto the court and your Honor that she and the Respondents, except Martha Packer, are the joint owners or tenants in common of all of the following described property situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

From the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 2 East, run East 1324.5 feet for a point or place of beginning; run thence East 219 feet to a point; run thence North 420 feet to a point; run thence West 219 feet to a point; run thence South 420 feet to the point or place of beginning.
