

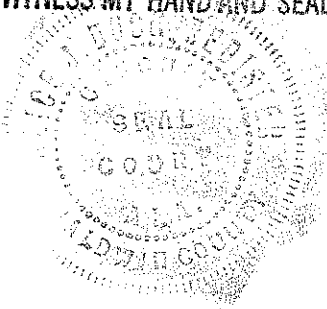

1. The petitioner, J. R. Hamilton, is the father of
James Hamilton, and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama,
and the petitioner further alleges that he is not the
guardian of James Hamilton, and that the said James Hamilton
has no guardian.

2. The said James Hamilton is a minor over the age
of eighteen years, a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama,
and owns personal property situated therein. That the
said James Hamilton is a minor of mature judgment, is
sober and industrious in all of his habits, is well
educated and fully capable of managing his affairs, his
estate and his property. That it is to the best interest
of said minor that his disabilities of non-age be removed.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that this Court will
take jurisdiction of this petition, and cause the usual
writ of process to the said James Hamilton to issue, and
that he be required to appear, and plead, answer or demur
within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the
rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made
and provided, and that upon the hearing of said petition,
that a decree be rendered relieving the said James Hamilton
of his disabilities of non-age and permitting him to sue
and be sued, contract and be contracted with, in all respects
as though he were twenty-one years of age.

general relief as he may be equitably entitled to, the
premises considered.
