TO THE HONORABLE H. M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes your Complainant, George A. Hall, and respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:

- l. That he is over the age of twenty-one years and that he is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint; that Rosalyn Zimmer Hall, the Respondent in this cause, is over the age of twenty-one years.
- 2. That on, to-wit, the 24th day of February, 1943, your Complainant and the Respondent were intermarried at De Land, Volusia County, Florida, and that your Complainant and the Respondent are still lawfully married.
- 3. That there has been born of said marriage three minor children, whose names and ages are respectively: Richard J.Hall, age 14; Robert M. Hall, age 11; and Joseph G. Hall, age 8. That said minor children are in the custody of the Respondent.
- 4. That your Complainant and the Respondent have entered into an agreement with reference to a property settlement and the support and custody of the said minor children, which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.
- 5. Your Complainant further avers and charges that the Respondent, Rosalyn Zimmer Hall, separated from and abandoned your Complainant on, to-wit, the 1st day of May, 1956, without cause or justification, and that your Complainant and the Respondent since that date have been and are now living separate and apart.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that the Respondent be made a party respondent to this Bill of Complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and the statutes in such cases made and provided, requiring her to plead, answer, or demur, within the time and within the manner required by law; and that upon a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will enter a decree divorcing the Complainant from the Respondent, granting to the Complainant the right to remarry, and granting and awarding the Respondent the care, custody, and control of said minor children of the marriage; decreeing that the custody and support agreement heretofore entered and made a part of this Bill of Complaint be declared a just and fair agreement, and decreeing that the parties thereto live and abide and obey the terms of this said agreement; Complainant further avers that the said agreement is a reasonable, just, and proper agreement; and Complainant further prays that your Honor will grant such other, further, different, and general relief to which the Complainant may be entitled, as in duty bound he will ever pray.

AGREEMENT OF PARTIES CONTEMPLATING A DIVORCE WITH REFERENCE TO CUSTODY OF CHILDREN, SUPPORT OF CHILDREN, AND PROPERTY RIGHTS

STATE OF ALABAMA BALDWIN COUNTY

This agreement, made and entered into in triplicate, by and between George A. Hall, hereinafter called husband, and Rosalyn Zimmer Hall, hereinafter called wife, WITNESSETH:

That whereas, various and diverse disputes and unhappy differences have arisen between husband and wife, and they are separated and not now living together as husband and wife, and whereas it is the desire of the parties hereto to make a complete and final settlement of all their property, and to settle and adjust all marital interests, now, therefore, this agreement is made as follows:

- 1. The wife shall have the permanent care, custody, and control of the minor children, Richard J. Hall, age 14, Robert M. Hall, age 11, and Joseph G. Hall, age 8; the husband shall have the right of visitation at reasonable times and places.
- 2. The husband shall pay to the wife the sum of \$200.00 per month, each and every month hereafter for the support and maintenance of the parties' said minor children until such time as the oldest of said children shall have attained the age of eighteen years or the age of twenty-one years if said oldest child is in college; thereafter, the husband shall pay to the wife the sum of \$150.00 per month, each and every month thereafter for the support and maintenance of the next oldest and youngest children until such time as the next oldest of said children shall have attained the age of eighteen years or the age of twenty-one years if said next oldest child is in college; thereafter, the husband shall pay to the wife the sum of \$100.00 per month, each and every month thereafter for the support and maintenance of the youngest child until such time as the youngest child shall have attained the age of eighteen years or the age of twenty-one years if said youngest child is in college.
- 3. The husband further agrees to pay to said wife permanent alimony in the sum of \$150.00 per month, each and every month hereafter, until the death or remarriage of said wife, whichever shall first occur.
- 4. The husband further agrees and does hereby release and transfer to the wife as her sole property, all furniture and household furnishings owned by the parties that is now in possession of the wife. The husband also agrees and does hereby release and transfer to the wife as her sole property, one 1953 Buick automobile. The 1957 Dodge automobile that is now owned by the parties will become the sole property of the husband. All stocks, insurance, bonds and securities that are now owned by both parties will become the sole property of the husband.
- 5. The husband further agrees to apply the sum of \$9,000.00 upon the purchase of a home for the wife, within sixty (60) days after written notice to and demand upon said husband by said wife for same; provided, however, that the interest of the wife in said home shall be a life estate only, with remainder, in fee simple absolute, to Richard J. Hall, Robert M. Hall and Joseph G. Hall, children of the parties hereto.

6. It is further agreed that any and all property acquired by either parties subsequent to the date of this agreement shall be the separate property of said party acquiring the same; and each party agrees to execute for the other any and all papers necessary to complete the transfer of property herewith divided and apportioned. It is further agreed that the terms of this agreement may be incorporated in any decree of divorce which may be hereafter obtained by either party, and enforced by contempt proceedings if necessary.
