

EXAMINATION BY MR. OWENS: MR. AUGUST CARLSON, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, TESTIFIED: Will you state your name and address for the record? August Carlson, Silverhill, Alabama, Box 114. A. Mr. Carlson, you are the complaint in that certain/in Circuit Q. Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, against All of Block 5, Town of Silver Hill, Alabama, as per official Plat thereof Recorded in Miscelllaneous Book 1 at page 59, and against Isidore J.
