My name is Lynn Winters Moon; I am the complainant in that certain divorce action against Luke P. Moon; Mr. Moon and I are both resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama, and both of us are over 21 years of age; we were married in Lucedale, Mississippi, on the 16th of October, 1952, and we moved into our home on the Bon Secour River shortly afterward; We lived there until September 26, 1957, on that day, when I came home from work, Mr. Moon was in a surly mood; he tried to goad me into an argument, but I refused to argue; he then became violent, first shouting and throwing furniture and dishes about the house; then he struck me in the face and chest, with his clinched fist; my mouth began bleeding and one eye was swelling from his blows; when he came at me again, threatening to "knock my head off", I was mortally afraid, and ran from the house; we haven't lived together since that night; I am deeply fearful of further bodily harm if we were together again. My bruises caused by his blows required medical attention.

Comes your complainant, Lynn Winters Moon, and respectfully shows and avers unto your Honor and the Court as follows:



3. Your complainant further avers and charges that on the 26th day of September, 1957, the respondent, Luke P. Moon, committed acts of physical violence to your complainant and upon her person and body, attended with great danger to her health and life, that the respondent prior to and on the 26th day of September, 1957, made numerous threats to do her physical harm, and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit further actual physical violence upon her person attended with danger to her health and life; that on, to-wit: the 26th day of September, 1957, she separated from and abandoned the said respondent, and is now living separate and apart from him.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, complainant prays that the respondent be made a party respondent to this Bill of Complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and the statutes in such cases made and provided, requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time and within the manner provided by law; and that on a

final hearing of this cause that your Honor will enter a decree divorcing your complainant from the said respondent, granting both parties the right to remarry; and complainant further prays that your Honor will grant such other, further, different, and general relief to which the complainant may be entitled, as in duty bound she will ever pray.





3. He denies each and every allegation contained in paragraph 3 of said Bill of Complaint and demands strict proof thereof.


