That your Complainant and the Respondent married in Lucedale, Mississippi, on April 13, 1953, and lived together as husband and wife until on, to-wit, November 25, 1953.

That on, to-wit, November 25, 1953, while your Complainant and Respondent were living together as husband and wife, in Baldwin County, Alabama, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of your Complainant and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

There was born as fruits of this marriage between the Complainant and the Respondent one child, Richard Eugene Byrd; that the mother of said child is a suitable, fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of this child.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure take the said Latsy A. Byrd, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring her to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

That the mother, Latsy A. Byrd, Respondent in this cause be awarded the care, custody and control of the infant child, Richard Eugene Byrd; that the Complainant herein having agreed to pay as maintenance and support for said child the sum of \$20.00, your Honor will upon a final hearing of this cause render a decree barring the bonds of matrimony between the parties to this cause and provide the agreed sum of \$20.00 per month as maintenance and support for said infant, and your Complainant prays for such other, further, or general relief to which he may be entitled, and your Complainant prays, etc.
