DECREE RELIEVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

EX PARTE: CHARLES BANKESTER

This cause coming on to be heard upon the verified petition of Morris Bankester as the father of Charles Bankester for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of the said Charles Bankester, and the testimony of witnesses having been taken by affidavit pursuant to the direction of the Court.

And it appearing to the Court that the said Charles Bankester is a minor over the age of eighteen years; that both he and the petitioner are residents of the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama; that petitioner is the father of said child; that he has no legal guardian; and it further appearing to the Court that it will be to the best interests of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Charles Bankester be, and he is hereby, relieved of the disabilities of non-age and invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts and deeds which he could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age; that a duly certified copy of this decree be filed for record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the petitioner pay the costs in this behalf incurred.

Your Petitioner, Morrie Bankester, respectfully shews unto this

That he is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin
