This cause nowcoming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the petition, notices and affidavits as shown by a note of submission; and, upon consideration thereof, the court is of the opinion and finds that all the allegations of the petition are true: That the said Bonnie Ruth Cadwell is a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years; that she is a resident of Baldwin County and is for her age a person of mature judgment, of sober and industrious habits, and is competent and capable in every way of handling her own affairs, and is the owner of property; that the said Mattie Cadwell Welch is duly and legally appointed guardian of the said minor and has joined in her petition for the removal of the disabilities; the court further finds that it is to the interest of such minor to grant the prayer of her petition; it is, therefore,

Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court:

1. ~~That the said Bonnie Ruth Cadwell be and she is hereby relieved~~ from the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and in general to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if she were twenty-one years of age.

2. That the said Bonnie Ruth Cadwell file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate in each county in the State where said minor shall do any business or make any contracts.

3. That the petitioners pay the costs of these proceedings to be taxed by the register, for which execution may issue.
