- 4. Complainant further shows to the Court that there was born of this marriage two (2) children, Darrell Ronald Jones, age 2½ years, and Craig Rodney Jones, age 7 months, who are in the care, custody and control of the Complainant. Complainant further shows unto the Court that the Respondent is financially able to pay the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per month for the maintenance and support of the two minor children, and pay all medical, dental, drug or hospital charges for said children. PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that Burnice

Earl Jones, Jr., be made a party defendant of this cause by the usual process of this Honorable Court, by Registered Mail, requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause, that she be granted a divorce from the said Burnice Earl Jones, Jr., and that she be granted custody and control of the minor children hereinabove named. Complainant further prays that the Respondent be required to pay the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) to her for the support and maintenance of the minor children, Darrell Ronald Jones and Craig Rodney Jones, and pay all medical, dental, drug or hospital charges for said children. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that she be granted such other, further, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

Burnice Earl Jones, Jr., is gainfully employed at Chemstrand Corporation and is financially able to pay to me the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per month for the maintenance and support of these two children, and in addition, to pay all medical, dental, drug and hospital charges or expenses incurred for the children. My name is Irene C. Jones. I am over the age of twenty-one years and for the children.
