DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for final decree upon the pleadings and proof as noted by the Register; and upon consideration thereof, the Court finds that the Petitioner, MYRTLE BUCK, is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and that she is the Mother of JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK; that the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK are minors over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years; that said minors are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the Father of said minors is dead; that said minors have no legal guardian; that a copy of the Petition of MYRTLE BUCK for the removal of the disabilities of the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK has been served upon the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK are of sufficient intelligence to be entrusted with the management of their estates; that they have a good education and mature judgment; and that it would be to their best interests that their disabilities of non-age be removed; IT IS, THEREFORE,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK be and they are hereby relieved of from the disabilities of non-age, and are now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and to do and perform all things which said minors could lawfully do on their becoming of the age of twenty-one years; IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that a certified copy of this Decree be filed in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and in each of the Counties in which said minors shall hereafter reside, and in the Office of the Judge of Probate of each County in the State in which said minors shall do any business or make any contracts. IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Petitioner pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.



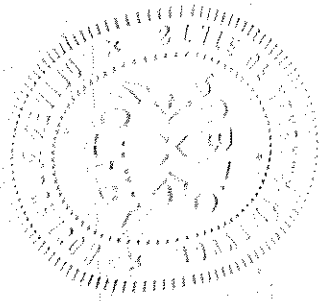

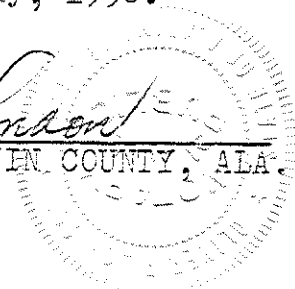

6. That no legal guardian for said minors has been appointed.

WHEREFORE, THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Your Petitioner prays

this Honorable Court to set this Petition down for a day to be heard, and will direct the issuance of notice to the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK of the filing of this Petition and of the day set to hear and determine the same, in manner as provided by law; and that upon the hearing hereof may it please the Court to make and enter a decree unconditionally relieving the said JIMMIE LOU BUCK AND JOYCE FAYE BUCK of the disabilities of non-age; and that this Honorable Court make all such orders and decrees in the premises as to it may seem just and proper.

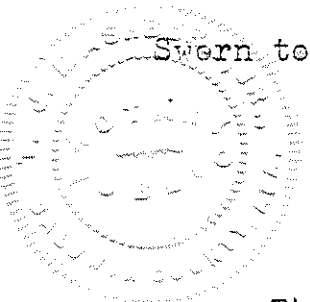
