FINAL DECREE:

This cause coming on to be heard on this date was submitted on the answer and cross-bill heretofore filed in this cause by the Respondent and Cross-complainant, answer and waiver filed by the Complainant and Cross-respondent, and testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of all of which the court is of the opinion, that the Complainant and Cross-respondent is not entitled to the relief prayed for by him in his original Bill of Complaint and the court is further of the opinion that the Respondent and Cross-complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for by her in her answer and cross-bill.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Cross-respondent and the Respondent and Cross-Complainant be, and the same are hereby dissolved and the said Edna B. Wallace is forever divorced from the said George H. Wallace for and on account of cruelty.
2. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that neither party to this suit shall again marry, except to each other, until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry, except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.
3. It is further ORDERED that the Complainant and Cross-respondent and the Respondent and Cross-Complainant be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the costs of this suit.
4. It is further ORDERED that the Complainant and Cross-respondent, George H. Wallace, pay the costs herein to be taxed,

for which execution may issue.



That on, to-wit, June 15, 1953, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of your Complainant and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.



ANSWER AND CROSS BILL

Now comes the Respondent, Edna B. Wallace, and for answer to the Bill of Complaint filed against her in this cause and for her Cross Bill says:

1. She admits the allegations of paragraph numbered 1 of the Bill of Complaint.
  2. She admits the allegations of paragraph numbered 2 of the Bill of Complaint.
  3. She denies the allations of paragraph numbered 3 of the Bill of Complaint and demands strict proof thereof.
  4. For further answer to the Bill of Complaint, the Respondent alleges that the Complainant did at various times, prior to October 25, 1953, make numerous threats of doing her bodily and physical harm; that on to-wit, October 25, 1953, the said Complainant did assault, beat, hit and strike Respondent; that Complainant has committed actual violence on her person attended with danger to her life or health, and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit an actual violence upon her person attended with danger to her life and health. That during the year 1955, the Complainant voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of the Respondent and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.
- Respondent alleges that it has been necessary for her to employ an attorney to represent her in this suit which was brought by the said Complainant and that she is without funds to pay her said attorney for services rendered and to be rendered by him in this cause.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS:

Respondent prays that this answer be taken and treated in all respects as a Cross Bill and that the usual process of

this Honorable Court issue to Complainant and Cross-Respondent, George H. Wallace, requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur to this Cross Bill within the time prescribed by law and under the rules and practice of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF:


Respondent and Cross-Complainant respectfully prays for the following separate and several relief:

1. That the Court will make and enter a proper decree divorcing the Respondent and Cross-Complainant from the Complainant and Cross-Respondent and will fix a reasonable monthly amount to be paid to the Respondent and Cross-Complainant as alimony.

2. That the Court will ascertain and fix a reasonable amount to be paid by the Complainant and Cross-Respondent to the Respondent's and Cross-Complainant's Solicitor of record for services rendered and to be rendered in this cause.

3. Respondent and Cross-Complainant further prays for such other, further and general relief as she may be equitably entitled to, the premises considered.
