and decree, that due and proper notice of the pendency of the said

Gale, if living, and if they or either of them be dead, then the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives and assigns of such of them as are deceased, and any and all other persons, firms, associations or corporations, claiming any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof, has been given in the manner required by law, and the complainants are entitled to the relief as prayed for in the bill of complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, ASCERTAINED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that the said complainants, Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, who are over the age of twenty-one years, at the time of the filing of the said bill of complaint and at the time of the submission of this cause for final decree, the complainants were and are in the actual and peaceable possession, claiming to own the same absolutely, and in fee simple of all that certain tract of land situated in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, described as follows, to-wit:

of which sale is recorded in Sales Book 9, page 88; who acquired title by mesne conveyances from the United States Government; that complainants further hold title to the said lands by adverse possession of the said lands and each and every parcel thereof continuously for more than ten years next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint; that the title to the said lands and each parcel thereof stands in the name of the complainants upon the records of Baldwin County, Alabama; that for more than ten years next preceding the filing of said bill of complaint no person other than those through whom they claim title to the said lands or any part thereof have assessed or paid taxes thereon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, at the time of the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause and at this time had and have the fee simple title to the above described lands, and to each and every part and parcel thereto, that neither of the defendants, Baldwin County Colonization Company, a corporation, its alienees, successors and assigns, Rose Bartling, Vera G. Bartling, Lucille Serena Bartling, Herbert W. Bartling and William M. Gale, if living, and if dead, their unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives and assigns, nor any and all other persons, firms, associations or corporations have any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the title hereby quieted and established in and declared to be in the said Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, shall inure to the benefit of all persons deriving title to said lands or any part therein, from or through the said Ellis A. 

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, ASCERTAINED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that the said complainants, Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, who are over the age of twenty-one years, at the time of the filing of the said bill of complaint and at the time of the submission of this cause for final decree, the complainants were and are in the actual and peaceable possession, claiming to own the same absolutely, and in fee simple of all that certain tract of land situated in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of Section 25, Township 8 South, Range 5 East, run thence East along the North line of said Section 3639 feet to a point of beginning; thence South and parallel with the West line of said Section 628 feet to a point; thence East and parallel to the North line of said Section 666 feet, more or less, Perdido Bay; thence northwardly and following the meanders of Perdido Bay to the North line of said Section; thence West along the North line of said Section 1045 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, in Baldwin County, Alabama, being the lands conveyed to complainants by Amos Garrett and Sarah Garrett, his wife, by deed dated May 19, 1947, and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Deed Book 127 at page 30;

That the complainants obtained title to the said lands from Amos Garrett and Sarah Garrett on May 19, 1947 by deed recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate in Deed Book 127 at page 30; who acquired title by tax deed from the State of Alabama dated September 5, 1935 and recorded in said Probate office in Deed Book 58 NS, pages 367-8; who acquired the same under tax sale July, 1931, under assessment to Baldwin County Colonization Company, by

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, at the time of the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause and at this time had and have the fee simple title to the above described lands, and to each and every part and parcel thereto, that neither of the defendants, Baldwin County Colonization Company, a corporation, its alienees, successors and assigns, Rose Bartling, Vera G. Bartling, Lucille Serena Bartling, Herbert W. Bartling and William M. Gale, if living, and if dead, their unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives and assigns, nor any and all other persons, firms, associations or corporations have any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the title hereby quieted and established in and declared to be in the said Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, shall inure to the benefit of all persons deriving title to said lands or any part therein, from or through the said Ellis A. Whitfield and Minnie Whitfield, and the said title so quieted and established in them shall be treated and considered as established in favor of the said Ellis A.
