-FOURTH-

That the said Berry E. Cox has treated Oratrix in a cruel and inhuman manner since their said marriage and before she was compelled to leave him. That at different times he has committed actual violence on her person, attended with danger to life and health. That because of his conduct, which caused her reasonable apprehension of such violence she was compelled to leave his house, together with her children, and go with them to live with her brother.

-FIFTH-

That the said Berry E. Cox is possessed of a sufficient estate, *and his earning capacity is such as to* real and personal, [^]to enable him to pay Oratrix alimony "pendente lite" and to maintain and support Oratrix and their two minor children above named who are living with her, in a manner suitable to her condition in life. That the said Berry E. Cox has failed to so maintain and support she and the two minor children for many months past

-PRAYER FOR PROCESS-

The Premises considered, Oratrix prays that Your Honor will caused to be issued out of this Honorable Court a summons to the said Berry E. Cox, requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur, to this Bill of Complaint within the time required by law. That Your Honor will order a reference to be held to ascertain the extent and value of the estate ^{and earning capacity} of the said Berry E. Cox, real and personal and also to ascertain what allowance will be proper for alimony "pendente lite" and also what allowance will be proper for the maintenance and support of Oratrix and said minor children above named and such other orders and decrees that are necessary and incident to the granting of the relief herein prayed.

That Your Honor will also grant unto her an allowance, consistent with the extent and value of the estate of Berry E. Cox and suitable to the condition in life of Oratrix and said minor children, out of the estate of said Berry E. Cox for the maintenance and support of Oratrix and for maintenance, support and education of the minor children and such other and further, or further and different relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled and which, to your Honor will seem meet and proper, And, as in duty bound, she will ever pray, etc., etc.,





I know of no cause that Mrs. Cox gave Mr Cox to justify him in treating her as he did.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said Ada C. Cox
shall not again marry except to said Berry E. Cox,
until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days she shall not marry again except
to said Berry E. Cox, during the pendency of said appeal.




