DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted on behalf of the Petitioner on her sworn petition, the order of this Court setting this date for the hearing of the same and the affidavits of G. Mac Humphries and E. S. Tunstall; and the said Robert Wayne Howell having been given notice of the filing of the petition to remove his disabilities of non-age and of the day set for the hearing of the same as required by law; and the Court having considered the same is satisfied that it would be to the interest of such Minor to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age and that the disabilities of non-age of the said Robert Wayne Howell, A Minor eighteen years of age, should be removed; it is, therefore

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the disabilities of non-age of Robert Wayne Howell, A Minor eighteen years of age, be, and the same hereby are, removed, and he be, and he hereby is, relieved from the disabilities of non-age and he hereby is vested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts which such Minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that said Minor file a certified copy of this decree relieving him from the disabilities of non-age in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and in each of the Counties in which said Minor shall hereafter reside, and in the Office of the Judge of Probate of each County in the State where said Minor shall do business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Petitioner, Mary S. Howell, be, and she hereby is, taxed with the costs of this proceeding, for which let execution issue.

ORDER
