TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY,
ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

Your Complainants, LLOYD L. REDDITT and LLOYD L. REDDITT, JR., respectfully show unto your Honors:

- l. That LLOYD L. REDDITT is over the age of twenty-one (21) years and is a resident of Mobile County, Alabama; that LLOYD L. REDDITT, JR., is a minor over the age of fourteen (14) years and resides with his father and guardian, LLOYD L. REDDITT, in Mobile, County, Alabama, said letters of guardianship over the person and estate of said LLOYD L. REDDITT, JR., marked Exhibit "A" and attached hereto, were granted to the said LLOYD L. REDDITT by the Probate Court of Mobile County, Alabama, on the 13th day of May, 1954, Case No. 5996 N.S.; that the respondent, FRANK G. REDDITT is over the age of twenty-one (21) years and is a resident of Mobile County, Alabama; and that the Respondent EDWARD R. REDDITT, is over the age of twenty-one (21) years and resides in Citronelle, Mobile County, Alabama.
- 2. That complainants, together with the respondents, jointly own in fee simple the following described real property all of which is situate in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 4 in Shellbanks, a Subdivision of Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, as per plat there-of recorded in Book 1, page 678 of the Public Records in the office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama.

That the full and complete title to the real property described in said survey as parcel or Lot No. 1 and more particularly described as follows, viz: The West ½ of the West ½ of Lot No. 4, of the Kennedy survey and Plat of Shellbanks, in the Drury Tract, Section 23, T9S, R2E, in Baldwin County, Alabama, being a strip of land 82.5 feet in width, shall pass and be vested by this Court in Frank G. Redditt;

That the full and complete title to the real property described in said survey as parcel or Lot No. 2 and more particularly described as follows, viz: The East ½ of the West ½ of Lot No. 4, of the Kennedy survey and Plat of Shellbanks, in the Drury Tract, Section 23, T9S, R2E, in Baldwin County, Alabama, being a strip of land 82.5 feet in width, shall pass and be vested by this Court in Edward R. Redditt:

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainants pray that the said Frank G. Redditt and the said Edward R. Redditt be made parties respondants to this bill of complaint and that they be required to plead, answer or demur to the same, within the time required by law and the rules of this Honorable Court, or failing therein that a decree pro confesso be entered against them, and that upon the hearing hereof this Court will make or render a decree directing that said property be partitioned among the joint owners as prayed for by complainants, or as to this Court may seem just and equitable and will make such other, further and additional orders or decrees so as to vest in the several owners thereof such portion of said property as may be alloted or partitioned to them upon such partition. And that if Complainants are mistaken in the relief specifically prayed for, they pray for such other, further or different relief to which they may be entitled, and the facts of the case justify, and, as in duty bond, will ever pray.


