Notice is hereby given to each and all of the respondents named below and to all persons, firms or corporations claiming any right, title or interest in, lien or encumbrance on the lands hereinafter described, or any part thereof, that Harry Miller, did, on the 20th day of May, 1955, file in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Equity, a verified Bill of Complaint against the following described real property situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31, Township 4 South, Range 3 East.

and against Charles A. Twining, Abraham Edwards and James A. Carney, and against the heirs and devisees of such of the said parties as may be dead and against any and all persons, firms or corporations claiming any title to, interest in, or lien or encumbrance on, the said lands or any part thereof.

The said James A. Carney is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, (Daphne).

The address of Abraham Edwards and Charles A. Twining are unknown and cannot be ascertained after reasonable effort and the making of diligent inquiry to ascertain the same.

The said Bill of Complaint has been filed for the purpose of establishing the title of the said complaint to all of the said lands, for the purposes of quieting his title thereto and to clear up all doubts and disputes concerning the title to the said property.

Complainant claims the absolute fee simple title to all of the said lands under, from, by and through the following conveyance:

Deed from Ort H. Ertzinger and Ottilla M. Ertzinger dated February 25, 1954, and recorded in Deed Book 205 at Page 553, Baldwin County, Alabama Probate Records.

The complainant, in and by his said Bill of Complaint, alleges and avers that he owns the said lands in his own right, absolutely and in fee simple; that he is in the actual peaceable possession of the said lands under claim of ownership; that the title to the said lands stands upon the records in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, the county where the said lands are situated, in the name of the complainant; that no suit is pending to test complainant's title to, interest in, or right to the possession of the said lands or any part thereof; that complainant and those through whom he claims title have held color of title to and have regularly assessed and paid taxes on the said lands and each and every part thereof for ten or more consecutive years next prior to the filing of the said Bill of Complaint; and that no persons, firms or corporations, other than the complainant and those through whom he claims title to the said lands, have paid any taxes on the said lands or any part thereof or any interest therein, and no persons, firms or corporations, other than the complainant and those through whom he claims title, have had possession of the said lands or any part thereof, within ten years next prior to the filing of the said Bill of Complaint.

The respondents named above and all persons, firms or corporations claiming any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance on the said lands, or any part thereof, must appear in this court and plead, answer or demur to the said Bill of Complaint before the 26th day of June, 1955, or at the expiration of thirty days from the said date decrees pro confesso will be taken against them, testimony will be thereafter taken and the cause submitted for a final decree quieting complainant's title to the said lands.

STIPULATION:

James R. That Mr. Owen accepted the appointment and filed an answer denying the allegations of the bill of complaint on, to-wit: 18th day of July, 1956; that Mr. Owen is presently absent from Baldwin County, on a tour of active duty of the armed forces of the United States, and the Judge of the Circuit Court, Hubert M. Hall, has appointed James A. Hendrix of Robertsdale, Alabama, a practicing Attorney at the Baldwin County Bar, to act in the place and stead of James R. Owen; that he is present at this hearing on this date.

MR. MASHBURN: I offer in evidence certified Photostatic copy of confirmation deed from United States of America, to Josiah Thompson, which deed is of record in Deed Book S. at pages 602-608, Probate Office of Baldwin County, Alabama, and ask that it be Marked Complainant's Exhibit 1.

Next, I offer in evidence certified copy Photostatic copy - of a deed from W. R. Stuart,
as Probate Jugge, Baldwin County, Alabama, to
Ort H. Ertzinger, which deed appears of record in

the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Deed Book 168 at page 80, and ask that it be marked Complainant's Exhibit 2.

Next, we offer in evidence a certified Photostatic copy of deed from Ort H. Ertzinger, and Ottilla M. Ertzinger, his wife, to Harry Miller, as Trustee for PEOPLE OF THE LIVING GOD, which deed is dated February 25, 1954, and of record in Deed Book 205 at page 553, Baldwin County Probate Records, and ask that it be marked Complainant's Exhibit 3.

MR. HARRY MILLER, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, TESTIFIED:

Direct Examination by Mr. Mashburn.

- Q. Are you Harry Miller?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. You are the complainant in this cause, Mr. Miller?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. You filed this bill of complaint as Trustee for the People of the Living God?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Now in 1954 did you purchase a piece of land in Baldwin County, Alabama, from Mr. Ertzinger and his wife?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did you purchase that land as Trustee for the People of the Living God?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Is your group incorporated?
- A. Yes sir.

- Q. After you purchased that land and secured the deed therefor,

 did you and your group, or the people you represent, go into
 possession of the land?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. In what ways have you exhibited your possession of the lands over the years since then?
- A. We did work removing stumps and we ran a scraping machine over it and we took off some trees that was im the way of some farm work that we were doing and put signs on it.
- Q. Are you getting ready to build a Church on this land?
- A. Community farm and school.
- Q. Have you had any one to interfere with your possession of this land?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Have you, as Trustee, assessed and paid the taxes on this land since you purchased it?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Have you continued in the quiet and peaceable possession of the land up to the present time?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did you record your deed from Mr. Ertzinger?
- A. Yes, it was recorded.
- Q. During the time since then have you personally, and through agents and attorney, attempted to find any one that might have any claim on this land?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did you employ an abstractor to make an abstract of this land, looking for people who might have a claim to the lands?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Has anybody filed suit against you or your group for this land?
- A. No sir.
- Q. At the time this suit was filed, or at the present time, was any suit pending to test the title of you and your group to this land?

- A. No sir.
- Q. Have you read this bill of complaint, Mr. Miller?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Are the allegations therein contained true and correct?
- A. Yes sir.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY JAMES A. HENDRIX, GUARDIAN AD LITEM:

- Q. Mr. Miller, at present you do not have any buildings on the property do you?
- A. No.
- Q. The only acts of possession you have exercised have been removing some stumps and timber, is that right?
- A. And doing grading work.
- Q. Have you fenced the land?
- A. No.
- Q. How much land is involved, do you know, Mr. Miller?
- A 20 acres.
- Q. You have actually been in possession of the land for about 3 years, is that right?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Do you know Mr. C. A. Twining?
- A. No, I don't know him.
- MR. MASHBURN: I offer in evidence the sworn bill of complaint filed in this cause.
- MR. ORT ERTZINGER, A WITNESS FOR THE COMPLAINANT, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, TESTIFIED:

Examination by Mr. Mashburn.

- Q. Is this Mr. Ort H. Ertzinger?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Where do you live, Mr. Ertzinger?
- A. Bay Minette, Alabama.
- Q. Did you, in 1948, purchase the North Half of Southeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter, Section 31, Township 4 South, Range 3 East from the State of Alabama for its taxes?
- MR. HENDRIX: You mean did he get a deed or buy it? (page 4)

- MR. MASHBURN: I said did he buy it.
- A. You said from the State I bought it from the County the Judge of Probate at tax sale.
- Q. On the 3rd day of August, 1951, did you receive a deed to that land from W. R. Stuart, Judge of Probate?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. After you purchased the land what did you do in regard to the possession?
- A. I went on the land and found some neighbors and we went over it and I was there at least a half dozen times; I didn't put up any signs, because I didn't have the three years possession but I got the people around there to look after it.
- Q. Did you assess and pay the taxes on the land?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did you try to find any one who might own, or be interested in the land?
- A. Yes sir. I represented this fellow, Twining for 20 years, and finally the letters I would write him would come back and I let the land sell for taxes. The letters would come back marked "Deceased".
- Q. I believe your firm made the abstract for Mr. Miller?
- A. Walter Lindsey made it for Ertzinger & Son.
- Q. No suit was filed against you testing the title or your right to possession of this land during the time you owned it?
- A. No sir.
- Q. How long did you own it before you sold it to Mr. Miller, as T_{r} usteefor the PEOPLE OF THE LIVING GOD?
- A. From '51 to '54.
- Q. And you assessed and paid taxes on it during that time?
- A. Yes sir.
- ON CROSS EXAMINATION OF THIS WITNESS BY JAMES A. HENDRIX, GDN AD. LITEM, HE TESTIFIED.
- Q. You visited the land about a half dozen times during the time you had it?
- A. Yes sir. As soon as I got possession I went down and found (page 5)

where it was.

- Q. You never cut the timber on it?
- A. No sir, the timber was cut but I didn't sell it; I went down and raised hell about it, but never did anything about it; one morning I went down and caught the negro that cut it and he ran out the back door and got in his automobile and left.
- Q. You ran him off, so to speak?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. In writing Mr. Twining, Mr. Ertzinger, were you able to determine whether or not he left any heirs, or were you able to contact any heirs, or devisees or grantees of Mr. Twining?
- A. No sir, the mail came back marked on the envelope "Deceased".

 The land had sold several times prior to this sale, and he never showed any willingness to redeem it. It sold one time in 1923 --
- Q. During the time you owned the land did you assess and pay taxes on it?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. To your knowledge did anybody else during the time you owned it assess and pay taxes on it?
- A. No.
- Q. Did any one claim the land?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Did any one ever try to dispossess you?
- A. No.

FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this 21st day of May, 1957, being the day regularly set for the hearing of Equity Cases in this Court, is submitted for final decree on behalf of the complainant on the Original Bill of Complaint; Order Designating Newspaper in which Notice of Pendency of Bill of Complaint Shall be Published; Notice of Pendency of Bill of Complaint; Proof of Publication of Notice of Pendency of Bill of Complaint; Motion for Decree Pro Confesso on Personal Service; Decree Pro Confesso on Personal Service; Motion for Decree Pro Confesso on Publication; Decree Pro Confesso on Publication; Decree of this Honorable Court dated July 17, 1956, appointing James R. Owen as Guardian ad Litem to represent any Unknown Minor and Persons of Unsound Mind Interested in this Proceeding and as Attorney to Represent Any Persons Interested in this Proceeding who may Be In The Military Service of the United States; The Action of This Honorable Court in Open Court Appointing Honorable James A. Hendrix to Act for Honorable James R. Ownns, who is away in Military Service; and the Testimony of Harry Miller and Ort H. Ertzinger heard ore tenus by the Court. with the Exhibits to their testimony; upon consideration of all of which it appears to the Court that the Respondents named in the Bill of Complaint have permitted a decree pro confesso to be taken against them; that the allegations of the bill of complaint are true; and that the complainant is entitled to a decree quieting

title to the lands described in the said bill of complaint; upon consideration of all of which, it is, therefore, CRDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That the complainant, HARRY MILLER, as Trustee for People of the Living God, an Incorporation, is the lawful owner in fee simple of the following described land situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31, Township 4 South, Range 3 East;

That the absolute fee simple title to the said lands and to each and every part thereof and all interest therein is in the Complainant, as Trustee, free and clear of and from the claim or claims of all persons, firms or corporations claiming any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance on the said lands, or any part thereof, or any interest therein; that the said complainant has, and is hereby given, judgment against the said lands and against all persons, firms or corporations claiming any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof.

- the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, shall record the said certified copy of this decree in the same book and manner which deeds are recorded, and shall index the same in the direct index in the names of CHARLES A. TWINING, ABRAHAM EDWARDS

and JAMES A. CARNEY, and shall index the same in the indirect or reverse index of said records in the name of HARRY MILLER, as Trustee Bor People of the Living God, an Incorporation.

- 5. The title hereby adjudged and decreed to be in the said Harry Miller, as Trustee, shall inure to the benefit of all persons who derive title to the said lands, or any part thereof, or any interest therein, from or through the said Complainant, and such title or interest shall be at all times treated and considered as though it had been established in favor of the person or persons so procuring or deriving title from the said complainant.
- The costs of this proceeding are pereby taxed against the complainant, for which execution may issue.

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Orator, Harry Miller, as Trustee for People of the Living God, presents this Bill of Complaint against the following described lands situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 31, Township 4 South, Range 3 East.

and against Charles A. Twining, Abraham Edwards and James A. Carney, and against the heirs and devisees of such of the said parties as may be dead and against any and all persons, firms and corporations claiming any title to, interest in, or lien or encumbrance on, the said lands or any part thereof, and, thereupon, your Orator complains and shows unto the court and your Honor as follows:

- 1. Your Orator is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Mobile County, Alabama.
- 2. James A. Carney is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. (Daphne)
- 3. Abraham Edwards and Charles A. Twining are, if living, over twenty-one years of age, but their respective places of residence and post office addresses are unknown and cannot be ascertained after reasonable effort and the making of diligent inquiry to ascertain the facts with regard thereto.
- 4. Your Orator is in the actual, peaceable possession of all of the above described lands situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, and claims to own the said lands in his own right, absolutely and in fee simple.
- 5. Your Orator holds color of title to and he and those through whom he claims title have maid taxes on the said lands for a period of ten or more consecutive years next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and no other persons, firms or corporations, other than your Orator and those through whom he claims title, have paid taxes on, or have been in possession of, the above described lands or any part thereof for a period of ten or more consecutive years prior to the filing of this Bill of Complaint.

- 6. Title to all of the said lands stands upon the records in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, the county where the said lands are situated, in the name of your Orator.
- 7. No suit is pending to test your Orator's title to, or right to possession of the said lands or any part thereof.
- 8. Your Orator has and claims to have the absolute unencumbered fee simple title to all of the real property herein described by and through the following instrument of writing which is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, the county where the said lands are situated, to-wit:

Deed from Ort H. Ertzinger and Ottilla M. Ertzinger dated February 25, 1954, and recorded in Deed Book 205 at Page 553, Baldwin County, Alabama Probate Becords.

9. Your Orator has made a diligent search and caused a diligent search to be made to ascertain the names, ages and addresses of all persons, firms or corporations who might make or who are making any claim to the said lands or any part thereof or any interest therein or encumbrance thereon. Your Orator further avers that these inquires have continued faithfully and diligently for the past three years; that during the summer of 1955 he employed an abstract company to make an examination of the records of Baldwin County, Alabama, and prepare an abstract of title to the above described property; that he employed an attorney to examine the abstract and the records in the Courthouse in Bay Minette, Alabama; that he has made and has caused his said attorney to make in-quiry about the ages, addresses and heirs of any persons interested or who may be interested in the said property; that your Orator has made and caused a thorough inquiry to be made in the vicinity where the said property is situated for the purpose of ascertaining any claimants to it and for any other information having any bearing on the title to the said property. All of the information so secured by your Orator and his attorney as to prior ownership and possession of the said property, the ages and places of residence of the individual respondents named herein and the status of all of the said firms or companies is as hereinabove set out.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Orator prays that the said lands hereinabove described, the respondents named herein and their heirs and devisees, if deceased, and the unknown heirs, devisees and personal representatives of the next of kin of the respondents named above who are dead, and all persons, firms or corporations claiming any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance on the said lands or any part thereof be made parties respondents to this Bill of Complaint and be brought into court by the usual and proper process.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Your Orator prays that each and all of the respondents named herein, their heirs and devisees, the unknown heirs, devisees, legal representatives and next of kin of such of the respondents named herein as are dead, and any and all persons, firms and corporations who claim to own the said lands, or any part thereof, or any interest therein, or any lien or encumbrance thereon, be required to set forth and specify such claim, right, title, interest, lien or encumbrance and how and by what instrument the same is derived and created; that a guardian ad litem be appointed to represent any of the unknown parties named in this proceeding who may be minors and insane persons; that an attorney be appointed to represent any of the parties named in this proceeding, known or unknown, who may be in the military service; that upon a final hearing of this cause it be Ordered, Adjuged and Decreed that your Orator, at the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, had the fee simple title of all the above described lands, and that none of the respondents herein specifically named, their heirs or devisees, or any other person, firm or corporation has any right, title or interest therein, or any part thereof, or any lien or encumbrance thereon, and that all doubts and disputes concerning the said property be cleared up,

and that your Orator's title to the said lands be fully and completely quieted. Your Orator prays for such other, further and general relief as he may be equitably entitled to, the premises considered.
