WHEREFORE, your Complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause, made by this bill of complaint, and by appropriate process make Mrs. Theresa Zimmer, James A. Carney, Ort H. Ertzinger, Bay Minette Land Company, a corporation, its alienees, successors and assigns, if living and if dead, then their unknown heirs, devisees and personal representatives, and any and all other persons, firms, associations or comporations, claiming any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part or parcel thereof, to-wit: The West half of the Southeast Quarter of the NorthwestQuarter of Section Eleven, Township Three South, Range Three East, parties respondent to this Bill ofComplaint and by appropriate process require them, and each of them separately and severally, to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree ascertaining and decreeing that the fee simple title, free of liens, claims and encumbrances to the said lands and each part and parcel there, is vested in your Complainant, Joseph Weaver, as against the said Mrs. Theresa Zimmer, James A. And further that in said decree your Honor will cause a certified copy of the decree to be filed in the Probate Office of Baldwin County, Alabama, and to be recorded therein and that in said decree your Honor will direct in whose name it shall be indexed in the direct and indirect indexes of the records thereof in said Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama; and Complainant further prays for such other, further, different and general relief as in equity may seem just and meet as Complainant will ever pray.
