actually believe that if she continued to live with the Respondent he would do
actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and
health.

There were no children born to this marriage and no property to be divided between the parties to this suit.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that Your Honor will by proper process make the said Haskew Young party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, Your Honor will enter a decree forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent; that Your Honor will grant your Complainant the right to resume her name of Edna Earl Hudson; your Complainant prays for such other, further, different, or general relief as she may in equity and good conscience be entitled to receive.


