doth depose and say as follows: "My name is STELLA CORNELIA EMMONS. I am the complainant in this cause and am over the age of twenty-one years. I am a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been for more than ten years next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint in this cause. The respondent, ROY EMMONS, is over the age of twenty-one years and is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. I was married to the respondent in Milton, Florida, on August 5, 1936. We lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County since our marriage. About three years ago, my husband began to drink heavily, and when under the influence of alcohol, he would become violently jealous of me. On many occasions over the past three years, he has accused me of other men and has threatened to kill me, either by shooting me with a gun, or cutting me with a knife. One night, about two and one-half years ago, he tried to hold me and get his knife out to cut my throat. In April of this year, I left him because I was afraid that he would kill me. I stayed away ten days, when he came after me, and swore that he would do better if I would return to live with him as his wife. I did return to him, but in just a short time, he was acting as badly as ever. On several occasions recently, he has threatened to shoot me, and I have finally become convinced that, should I ~~continue to live with him as his wife~~ continue to live with him as his wife, he will carry out his threats and commit actual violence on my person which would necessarily endanger my life or health. I am convinced that it will no longer be safe for me to live with him as his wife. " Further deponent says not.
