I did return to him, but in just a short time, he was acting as
badly as ever. On several occasions recently, he has threatened
to shoot me, and I have finally become convinced that, should I
KAKWKWXKAXXXX continue to live with him as his wife, he will carry
out his threats and commit actual violence on my person which would
necessarily endager my life or health. I am convinced that it will no longer be safe for me to live with him as his wife. "Further
