

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for final decree upon the original Bill of Complaint, Order designating newspaper in which Notice of Pendency of Bill of Complaint will be published; Notice of Pendency of Bill of Complaint; proof of publication of Notice of Bill of Complaint; Register's Certificate as to service,: as to Joseph B. Blackburn, Carney Lumber Company, a Corporation, Marshall Carney, James A. Carney, Fannie Carney; Motion for decree pro confesso, decree pro confesso; as to Bay Minette, Land Company: Bill of Complaint, Demurrer; Amended Bill of Complaint, Answer to Amended Bill of Complaint, Appointment of Commissioner to take testimony; Testimony of Mrs. Louise Lovett, C. E. Garrett, and Sam Henry Overstreet, witnesses for the Complainants, Respondent, Bay Minette Land Company offering no testimony all of which has been noted by the Register; upon consideration of all of which, it appears to the Court that the Complainants are entitled to the relief prayed for them in their said Amended Bill of Complaint; WHEREUPON, IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

Lovett, deceased, shall inure to the benefit of all persons who derive title to the said lands, or any part thereof, or any interest therein, from or through the said Complainants, and such title or interest shall be at all times treated and considered as though it had been established in favor of the person or persons so procuring or deriving title from the said Complainants.

6. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxes against the Complainants for which execution may issue.
