IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court, that the said Doris Marie Childress be, and she is hereby, relieved of the disabilities of non-age and invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts and deeds which she could lawfully do if she were 21 years of age.
