TESTIMONY OF ETHEL SUMMERALL, WITNESS ON BEHALF OF THE COMPLAINANT.

My name is Ethel Summerall and I have known the Complainant in this cause all of my life. The Complainant is the husband of the Respondent and they were married to each other on October 13, 1950, in Lucedale, Mississippi. Both the Complainant and the Respondent are each over the age of twenty-one years and both the Complainant and the Respondent are bona-fide resident citizens of Mobile County, Alabama and have been such for more than one year next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint herein. There are no children as issue of their marriage. The Respondent's maiden name was Jessie Louise Lewis. The Respondent has committed adultery with one or more men since her marriage to the Complainant. I have seen the Respondent on several occasions with men other than the Complainant. I have seen the Respondent in beer joints with divers of men and she would be very loving and intimate with these men. I have also been present when the Respondent has left several of these places to go in a car with a man and when they left they were alone and they headed towards the outskirts of town. On one occasion I went with the Complainant to get the Respondent and when we found her she was at Bubba White's Tourist Court and when we approached the cabin the lights were off, we knocked on the door and the Complainant's wife answered the door and the lights came on. The Respondent was only partly dressed and her clothes were wrinkled and her hair mussed. I do not think that the Complainant should live with the Respondent again because of his conduct with other men.

There are no children as issue of our marriage. The Respondent in this cause would like to resume the use of her former name of Jessie Louise Lewis in the event a decree of divorce is granted herein. The Respondent has committed adultery with one or more males since our marriage to each other. I have seen the Respondent on numerous occasions with other men but on each of these occasions when I would catch up with her she would beg me to forgive her and say that she would change and be a good wife/ On one particular occasion the Respondent was out practically all night and I was worried about her so I began to look for her at all the local beer joints. When I finally found her she was at Bubba White's Tourist Court out on Highway 45 and I found her in a Tourist Cabin with a man who was not known to me. I knocked on the door and the lights went on and my wife came to the door about half dressed with her clothing wrinkled and her hair very messed up. She has admitted to me on several occasions that she has had sexual intercourse with men other than myself and that she could not be a true wife to me because of her desire for other men.

## DECREE OF DIVORCE

The Defendant is hereby awarded the 1950 Cheverolet automobile and the household furnishings and furniture located on Lott Road, Mobile, Alabama.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Defendant be, and she is hereby granted the right to resume the use of her former name of Jessie Louise Lewis.

The Court retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of making such other or further order or decrees as may be necessary as to the carrying out of said agreement by said parties as the Court may deem proper, and as changed conditions may require.
