This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree and Confession on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Artie V. Stabler is forever divorced from the said Ellie E. Stabler for and on account of Voluntary abandonment

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Complainant be and she is hereby awarded the custody of the minor children, Wyman D. Stabler, Dennis E. Stabler and John L. Stabler, subject to the right of visitation on the part of the Respondent at reasonable times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Respondent pay to the Complainant towards the maintenance and support of the said minor children, Wyman D. Stabler, Dennis E. Stabler and John L. Stabler, the sum of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS per month, the first payment being due and payable on January 1, 1956.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Artie V. Stabler the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

Comes now the Respondent, ELLIE E. STAELER, and for answer to the Bill of Complaint heretofore filed against him in said cause says as follows:

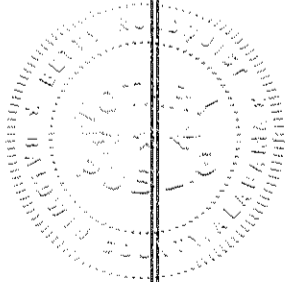
1. That he denies each and every allegation of the said Bill of Complaint and demands strict proof thereof.

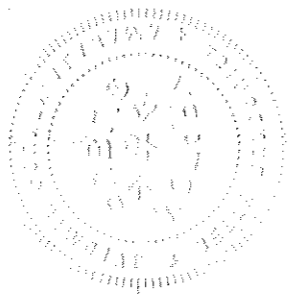

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY,

Sitting in Equity:

Comes now the Complainant, ARTIE V. STABLER, humbly complaining of the Respondent, ELLIE E. STABLER, in a matter of divorce, and represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST: That your Complainant, ARTIE V. STABLER, is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been a bona fide resident of said State and County for more than one year next preceeding the filing of this Bill of Complaint; that ELLIE E. STABLER is over the age of twenty-one years and whose address is 670 Trans. Trk. Co., Army Maneuver Support Command, Exercise Sage Brush, Camp Polk, Louisiana.

SECOND: That your Complainant and Respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, October 21, 1945, at Theodore, Alabama.

THIRD: Complainant further avers that said Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of Complainant for more than one year next preceeding the filing of this Bill of Complaint, on or about, to-wit, March 1, 1953, since which time Complainant and Respondent have not lived together nor in any way recognized each other as husband and wife.

FOURTH: That your Complainant further avers that there were born to the union of the Complainant and Respondent three children, all boys, namely, WYMAN D. STABLER, age 8; DENNIS E. STABLER, age 7; and JOHN L. STABLER, age 6. And that said minor children are now in the care, custody and control of the Complainant, their mother; further that said Complainant is a fit and proper person to be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the said minor children.

FIFTH: Your Complainant further avers and shows unto your Honor that the Respondent, ELLIE E. STABLER, is an able-bodied man, well able to provide for and maintain said minor children born to the union of the Complainant and Respondent in a manner suitable with his station in life; that the Complainant is now in the destitute condition and has no means of support for herself or the said minor

children.

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
PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Wherefore the premises considered the Complainant prays that the said ELLIE E. STAELER be made party Respondent to this her Bill of Complaint and that a summons be issued and served upon him as required by law and the rules of this Honorable Court, and that he be required to plead, answer or demur to the within Bill of Complaint within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the rules of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR FINAL RELIEF

The premises considered the Complainant prays that on a final hearing of this cause Your Honor will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent, and will grant to the Complainant a full and absolute divorce from the Respondent, and that in and by virtue of the said decree the Complainant will be granted the right to again contract marriage. The Complainant prays that in and by virtue of the said decree she will be awarded the custody of the minor children born to the union of the said parties, subject to the further orders of this Honorable Court and award an amount of money with which to support and maintain the minor children born to the union of said parties to be paid by the Respondent to the Complainant.

Complainant prays all other further and general relief to which she may be entitled, the premises considered and she will ever pray, etc.

There is no property settlement to be had between the parties.

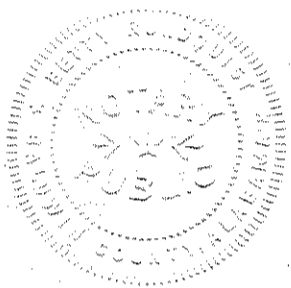
