This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Hazel Gill Raley is forever divorced from the said William E. Raley for and on account of Emultery.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED That the Complainant, Hazel Gill Raley shall have the right to use her former name, Hazel Gill.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Hazel Gill Raley the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness^{es} to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Hazel Gill Raley and Gertrude Brunell doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Hazel Gill Raley, I am over the age of 21 and a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than one year next preceeding. The Respondent is also over the age of 21 and is a resident of Alabama and has been more than one year next preceeding. We were married in Lucedale Mississippi on December 24, 1952 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama after several separations the final being November 22, 1955. On that occasion and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent had threatened and abused me that I was in fear of my life or health for his conduct on the last occasion and his rough treatment of me caused me to believe that if I continued to live with him he would carry out his threats out and do actual violence to me which would endanger my life or health. I had to leave him and have not lived with him as his wife since that date. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce. I respectfully ask the right to use my former name of Hazel Gill.

That my name is Gertrude Brunell, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and have been residents of Alabama more than one year next preceeding. They were married at Lucedale, Mississippi on December 24, 1952 and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama until November 22, 1955 though they separated on several occasions through no fault of the Complainant so far as I know. On November 22 the Complainant was forced to leave the Respondent because of his conduct and threats causing her, from his actions, to believe that if she stayed there her life or health would be endangered. His conduct has caused her to leave him on numerous other occasions but on this occasion it was so much more dangerous that I know she will never live with him any more. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided.



Paley, party respondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law, and the practice of this Honorable Court; your Complainant further prays that your Honor will upon a final hearing hereof, award to her a decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent.
