
2. That the Complainant and Respondent were lawfully married on, to-wit, November 12, 1952.

Testimony of Eunia V. Sanspree :

My name is Eunia V. Sanspree. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, having been such a resident citizen for more than one year. James Rayford Sanspree is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married on November 12, 1952, and lived together as man and wife until February of 1955, at which time because of the violence committed on my person and the threats of violence I was forced to live separate and apart from him. James Rayford Sanspree choked me, beat me with his fist and otherwise abused me, doing me actual physical, bodily harm, and threatened to do other and further harm attended with danger to my life and health. There are no children of this marriage.

Testimony of Mary Rowell:

My name is Mary Rowell. I am personally acquainted with Eunia V. Sanspree and James Rayford Sanspree, both of whom are over the age of twenty-one years, and both of whom are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama. They were married on November 12, 1952, and lived together as man and wife until February of 1955. There are no children of this marriage. I have seen and known of James Rayford Sanspree striking Eunia V. Sanspree with his fist and have heard him threaten to do her further physical harm. I have also seen bruises and marks on her ~~xxx~~ person which were the result of violence committed by James Rayford Sanspree. I believe that she should be reasonable convinced from his manner and conduct toward her that he would commit other and further violence, attended with danger to her life or health.
