DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

This cause now coming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the petition, order of the court setting a day for hearing the said petition and prescribing the method of taking testimony and affidavits as shown by the note of testimony upon consideration of all of which the court is of the opinion and finds that all of the allegations of the petition are true; that the said Cornelius Hartley is a minor over eighteen years of age and under the age of twenty-one years; that he is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and is for his age a person of mature judgment, of sober and industrious habits, and is competent and capable in every way of handling his own affairs, and is the owner of property situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, and the court further finds that it is to the best interest of the said minor to grant the prayer of the petition, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court as follows:

1. That the said Cornelius Hartley be and he is hereby relieved from the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and in general to do and perform all acts which said minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

2. That the Register of this court file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate in each county in the state where said minor shall do any business or make any contracts.

3. That the Petitioner pay the costs of these proceedings to be taxed by the Register, for which execution my issue.
