Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the respondent; and that a decree be made awarding to the respondent the care, custody and control of the minor child, Anthony Keith Walz, age about 20 months; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
