This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso, on
Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Bernice Wilson Hadley is forever divorced from the said Rayford Hadley for and on account of Cruelty.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant, Bernice Wilson Hadley, shall have the care custody and control of the minor child, Shelia Ann Hadley, age about fifteen months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Rayford Hadley, Respondent, shall pay to Bernice Wilson Hadley, Complainant, the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per month for the maintenance and support of the minor child, Shelia Ann Hadley, age about fifteen months.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Bernice Wilson Hadley the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

ALABAMA:

Your Complainant, Bernice Wilson Hadley, respectfully represents unto Your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

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That your Complainant is over the age of 18 and is presently a resident of Escambia County, Alabama, but was born and reared in Baldwin County, Alabama; The Respondent is over the age of 21 and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been more than one year next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint.

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That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Lucedale, Mississippi on April 3, 1954 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until February 26, 1955.

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That on February 26, 1955, and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.



There were born as fruits of this marriage between the Complainant and the Respondent one child, Shelia Ann Hadley, age about fifteen months, and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Rayford Hadley party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

That your Complainant be awarded the care, custody and control of the minor child, Shelia Ann Hadley, age about fifteen months; that your Honor will grant to the Complainant for maintenance and support for said child the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per month.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that a decree be made awarding to her the care, custody and control of the minor child, Shelia Ann Hadley, age about fifteen months; Your Complainant further prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

Eria Lee Harville doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Bernice Wilson Hadley, I am over the age of 18 and
am presently a resident of Escambia County, Alabama. The Respondent Rayford
Hadley is over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
We were married at Lucedale Mississippi on April 3, 1954 and lived together
as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until on or about February
26, 1955. The cause of the separation was the respondent failed to work
and support me and our baby Shelia Ann Hadley now age 15 months and when I
insisted that he do something about that he would abuse and mistreat me.
The last occasion, because of his treatment and threats he placed me in fear
of my life or health I was forced to leave him and take my baby going to
live with my parents. We have not lived together since that separation and
I know that I can never live with him again as his wife. I have had the
care, custody and control of the infant Shelia Ann Hadley fruits of our
marriage since birth and respectfully show unto this Honorable Court that I
am a fit suitable and proper person to have her care, custody and control
and ask that I be granted such. The Respondent is presently employed and
able to support our daughter. I feel that a minimum of \$30.00 a month is
necessary to maintain and support her and respectfully ask the court to order
the Respondent to pay the sum of \$30.00 per month as maintenance and support
for the said child.

That my name is Eria Lee Harville, I know both parties to this cause, the
Complainant is over the age of 18 and the Respondent is over the age of 21.
They were both born in Alabama and have lived here all their lives. They
were married in Lucedale, Mississippi on April 3, 1954 and lived together in
Baldwin County, Alabama as husband and wife until on or about February 26,
1955 at which time the Complainant left the Respondent in fear of her life
or health because of his abuse and threats. I know of no cause which she
gave him for such mistreatment. I do not believe they will ever live to-
gether again as husband and wife. There were born as fruits of their
marriage Shelia Ann Hadley, age now about 15 months. The Complainant Bernice
Wilson Hadley has had her care, custody and control since her birth and
I respectfully submit that she is a fit, suitable and proper person to have
the care, custody and control of this baby girl.
