## DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for a decree removing the disabilities of non-age of the petitioner, Julian C. Prine, a minor over eighteen years of age, who has no parents or guardian, on the sworn petition of the said minor; service of a copy of the said petition on the said minor; the decree of this court dated January 30, 1956, setting this cause for hearing on this date; order of publication; proof of publication; affidavit of Donald P. Cain and affidavit of C. L. White, from all of which it appears to the court that the allegations of the said petition are true and that the petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed for by him in the said petition, upon consideration of all of which it is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court as follows:

- l. Julian C. Prine, a minor over eighteen years of age, shall be and he is hereby relieved of and discharged from all of the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to contract and be contracted with; sue and be sued; to buy, sell and convey real property; and, generally, to do and perform all acts which he could lawfully do on his becoming twenty-one years of age.
- 2. The Register of this court shall file a certified copy of this decree for record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, and tax the cost of such recording as a part of the costs of this proceeding.
- 3. The said Julian C. Prine shall file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of each county in which he shall hereafter reside and in the office of the Judge of Probate of each county where he shall do any business or make any contracts.
  - 4. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against

the said Julian C. Prine, for which execution may issue.
