- 1. That he is over the age of 21 years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the respondent is over the age of 21 years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. That the respondent, Essie Mobles Kelly, were, heretofore, man and wife, until divorced by this Honorable Court on the 2nd day of April, 1954. The premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will decree a sale of the lands herein described by the Register of this Court for partition and division of the proceeds thereof. The Complainant further prays that the Court ascertain and fix a reasonable fee to be paid to the solicitor, and order that said fee be taxed as costs and paid from the common fund which may be received from the proceeds of the sale. The Complainant prays for such other, further and different relief as in equity and good conscience he may be entitled to receive.
