This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree Pro Confesso~~ Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said June Anice Dickman is forever divorced from the said Phillip K. Dickman for and on account of Cruelty.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Complainant, June Anice Dickman, shall have the care, custody and control of the minor children, Sylvia Irene Dickman, age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Respondent, Phillip K. Dickman, shall pay to the Complainant the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) DOLLARS per month as maintenance and support for the minor children, Sylvia Irene Dickman, age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Phillip K. Dickman the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

witness es named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 11th day of February 1956, at the office of C. LeVair Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness es to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said June Anice Dickman and Margaret Casperson doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is June Anice Dickman, I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and was born here in Baldwin County. The Respondent Philip K. Dickman is also over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married in Lucedale, Mississippi on August 13, 1950 and lived together as husband and wife until our last separation on January 12, 1955 having separated previously on two occasions but attempted two reconcilations which failed. The cause of our spearation being the mis-use and mistreatment of me by the Respondent who has by his mistreatment without fault on my part caused me to be in fear of my life or health as I believe if I continued to live with him and he carried out his threats and statements my life would be endangered. During his anger he has abused me so that I could not stay there but had to leave. One separation occurring in Ohio when I returned to Alabama because of his mistreatment of me and the last separation occurring here in Alabama for the same reason. I know I will never live with him again as his wife. There are two children born of this marriage Sylvia Irene Dickman age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one. I have had their care, custody and control since their birth and I respectfully represent that I am a fit, suitable and proper person to have their permanent care, custody and control and respectfully ask this Honorable Court to grant the care custody and control of these children to me. I respectfully represent to this Honorable Court that I need the sum of \$60.00 per month as maintenance and support for these children and will accept this amount from their father for them.

That my name is Margaret Casperson, I know both parties to this cause. They are both over the age of 21 and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama. They were married in Lucedale, Mississippi on August 13, 1950 and lived together as husband and wife until their last separation on January 12, 1956. They had separated two previous occasions but attempted reconciliation which has failed each time. The Complainant June Anice Dickman was forced to leave the Respondent on each occasion because of the abuse and mistreatment which he gave her. The last separation was caused by the same abuse and mistreatment so that she became in fear of her life or health and I know they will never live together again as husband and wife. The Complainant has had the care, custody and control of their children, Sylvia Irene Dickman age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one, since their birth and I respectfully represent that she is a fit, suitable and proper person to have their permanent care, custody and control.

That your Complainant is over the age of 21 and is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been more than one year next preceeding, the Respondent is over the age of 21 and a resident of Alabama and has been more than one year nexy preceeding.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married in Lucedale, Mississippi on August 13, 1950 and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama until January 12, 1955.

That on January 12, 1955, and on several ocassions prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.



There was born as fruits of this marriage between the Complainant and

the Respondent two children, Sylvia Irene Dickman, age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one, and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Phillip K. Dickman, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that a decree be made awarding to the Complainant the care, custody and control of the minor children, Sylvia Irene Dickman, age about three, and Timothy Hanson Dickman, age about one; That your Honor will grant to the Complainant as maintenance and support for said children the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars per month; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
