STATEMENT OF THOMAS EDWARD ADAMS:

My name is Thomas Edward Adams. I am fifteen (15) years of age, having been born on June 12, 1940. I am a resident of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama where I live with my parents. On February 11, 1956 at about 11:60 o'clock A. M. I entered into a marriage contract with Frances Lee Volking in Lucedale, Mississippi. At that time I did not know I had to have the consent of my parents nor did I have the consent of my parents. I did not fully realize the import of my actions.

Frances Lee Volking is sixteen (16) years of age and I do not believe that either of us realized the full implications of the marriage ceremony and considered the whole thing a "lark". We have not lived together as man and wife.

STATEMENT OF CHARLES EDWARD ADAMS:

My name is Charles Edward Adams. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. I am the father of Thomas Edward Adams, a minor of fifteen (15) years of age. On February 12, 1956 my son, Thomas Edward Adams informed me that he had entered into a marriage ceremony in Lucedale, Mississippi with Frances Lee Volking. I knew nothing of this pending marriage and did not give my consent thereto. My wife and the mother of Thomas Edward Adams is Puby A Adams and she did not give her consent to of Thomas Edward Adams is Ruby A. Adams and she did not give her consent to the marriage.

Thomas Edward Adams is a boy of the tender age as aforesaid and in my opinion is mentally incapable of fully realizing the implications of his entering into this marriage ceremony.

BILL TO ANNUL MARRIAGE OF MINOR BY NEXT FRIEND

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT, IN EQUITY SITTING:

Comes your Complainant, Thomas Edward Adams, Individually, and Thomas Edward Adams, a minor suing by his father and next friend, Charles Edward Adams, and respectfully represents and shows unto Your Honors as follows:

- 1. That the said Thomas Edward Adams is a minor of the age of, to-wit, fifteen years, having been born on, to-wit, June 12, 1940, and that his father and next friend is Charles Edward Adams, who is over the age of twenty-one years; that both he, the said Thomas Edward Adams and the said Charles Edward Adams, are resident citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the Respondent, Frances Lee Volking, is a minor under the age of eighteen years and that the said Frances Lee Volking is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. That on, to-wit, the 11th day of February, 1956, the said Thomas Edward Adams and Frances Lee Volking, without the knowledge or consent of the parents of Thomas Edward Adams, secured a marriage license and a marriage ceremony was performed in the town of Lucedale, Mississippi, purporting to unite the said Thomas Edward Adams and Frances Lee Volking in marriage.
- 3. That since the said purported marriage the said Thomas Edward Adams and Frances Lee Volking have not lived together as man and wife nor in any way recognized each other as such.
- 4. That at the time the said marriage license was obtained and at the time the said marriage ceremony was performed, the said Thomas Edward Adams was mentally incapable of entering into a valid contract of marriage; that at the time the said marriage license was obtained and at the time the said marriage ceremony was performed, the said

Frances Lee Volking was represented by her mother, Mrs. B. J. Volking, who had consented to the marriage of the said Frances Lee Volking; that the mother, Mrs. B. J. Volking, then and there knew that Thomas Edward Adams was incapable of entering into a valid contract of marriage; that it is to the best interests of both the said Thomas Edward Adams and Frances Lee Volking that the purported marriage be annulled and held for naught.

The premises considered, your Complainant makes party defendant to this Bill of Complaint the said Frances Lee Volking and prays that service may be had upon her in the manner required by law, and that a guardian ad litem may be appointed by this Honorable Court to defend this Bill in her behalf, and upon a hearing hereof your Complainant prays that this Honorable Court may annul and declare for naught the said purported marriage and may adjudge, and decree that the said Thomas Edward Adams and Frances Lee Volking are not legally married but are single persons, and your Complainant prays that he may have such other, further or different relief as in equity he may be entitled.
