Your complainant, Paul Winford, would respectfully represent and show unto this Honorable Court as follows:

- l. That he is twenty years of age, and is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the respondent is sixteen years of age and is a resident of Crittenden County, Arkansas.
- 2. That your complainant and the respondent intermarried in Mississippi County, Arkansas, on, to wit, October 3rd, 1955, and ever since have been and are now husband and wife.
- 3. That since the marriage of your complainant to the respondent, the said respondent has used actual violence on his person; striking him with her hands and fists, attended with danger to his life or health, or from her conduct there is a reasonable apprehension of such violence; and your complainant avers that on, to wit, the 28th day of December, 1955, the respondent separated from and abandoned the complainant, and is now living separate and apart from him.
