This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confession  
Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said

Thelma Kathleen Vinson Wilson is forever divorced from the said Carole Wilson for and on account of Cruelty.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant's parents, L. C. Vinson and Ellie Wilson, shall have the care custody and control of the minor child, Gregory Carole Wilson, age about nineteen months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Respondent, Carole Wilson, shall pay to the said L. C. Vinson and Ellie Wilson, the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per month as maintenance and support for the said minor child, Gregory Carole Wilson, age above nineteen months.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Thelma Kathleen Vinson Wilson the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



That my name is Thelma Kathleen Vinson Wilson, I am over the age  
of 18 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been all my life.  
The Respondent is over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County,  
Alabama and has been all his life. We were married on October 27, 1954 at  
Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together as husband and wife until on or  
about December 27, 1955 at which time I was forced to leave him because  
of his abuse and mistreatment of me. I do not know exactly what happened  
but when I got loose I was bruised about the face and especially around the  
mouth and was sore almost all over and afraid for my life or health. I  
know as the result of what happened at that time I can never live with him  
again as his wife. We have one child as fruits of our marriage, Gregory  
Onree Wilson, age about 19 months. I am willing and ask the court to  
place this child in the care, custody and control of my parents L. C. Vinson  
and Ellie Vinson, subject to the right of reasonable visitation on my part.  
I have no objection to the Respondent visiting our child so long as he  
supports him. My parents feel that \$20.00 per month is sufficient at this  
time for the maintenance and support of our child Gregory Onree Wilson and  
I am satisfied if the respondent supports our baby in accordance with  
this sum and in accordance with his emergency needs. I respectfully ask this  
Honorable Court for a divorce.

That my name is Ellie Vinson, I know both parties to this cause.  
Thelma Kathleen is over the age of 18 and Onree is over the age of 21. They  
were married at Lucedale, Mississippi on or about October 27, 1954 and

had separated one time previously. There was born as fruits of their marriage  
one child, Gregory Onree Wilson age about 19 months who has lived in my  
home all of his life. On or about December 27, 1955 Thelma and Onree had  
an altercation and Onree bruised her about the face and mouth so that she be-  
came afraid of her life or health and has not lived with him since that date,
