ORDER CONFIRMING COMMISSIONER'S SALE

This day came Alice J. Duck, the Commissioner heretofore appointed by the court, and moves the court that sale of the property of the joint owners thereof, heretofore made by said Commissioner in pursuance of the order made on the 26th day of February, 1957, appointing her Commissioner to sell certain property of said joint owners and by her duly reported to this court on March 19, 1957, be now confirmed by an order of this court.

And it further appearing to the satisfaction of the court from said report and from the evidence now therewith submitted that said property could not equitably divided or partitioned without said sale; that the said Commissioner had no personal or pecuniary interest in said sale, nor was she directly or indirectly a purchaser at said sale; that said sale was fairly conducted in strict accordance with law, and that said property sold for an amount not greatly less than its real value, and that all of the terms of sale, as prescribed by the court, have been complied with.

And it further appearing from the report that the said property was sold to W. C. Holmes and that he has paid the purchase money in full and that the property sold was situated in Baldwin County, Alabama and is described as follows:

FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for a final decree on the pleadings filed and decrees heretofore rendered in this cause, the stipulation heretofore entered
into by the solicitor for the complainant and the solicitor for
the respondent, Dr. W. C. Holmes, and the testimony of the witnesses, and the exhibits thereto, all as noted by the Register, from
all of which the court finds as follows:

- A. The property involved in this suit has been here-tofore sold under the authority of the former orders and decrees rendered in this cause, which sale has been confirmed, for the total sum of Forty-seven Hundred Dollars (\$4700.00).
- B. The interest of each party to this cause in the net proceeds of the said sale and the amount hereinafter ordered to be paid into court by Dr. W. C. Holmes is as set forth in the original Bill of Complaint.
- C. The court costs incurred in this proceeding, including the amount paid for the abstract, which is a common charge against the parties hereto, except Dr. W. C. Holmes, amount to \$313.10.
- D. The respondent, Dr. W. C. Holmes, has paid taxes on the said property involved in this suit in the amount of \$165.73. The interest on these amounts so paid is \$110.13.
- E. The attorney's fee of \$888.56 allowed to James R. Owen, as solicitor for complainant, for services rendered by him in this cause, and fixed as hereinafter provided, is also a common charge against all of the parties to this proceeding, except Dr. W. C. Holmes.

F. The value of the timber cut from the said property by the respondent, Dr. W. C. Holmes, on or about January, 1956, is \$586.55, and the value of the tops of the said timber so cut is \$106.26.

G. The total of the selling price of the said property, the timber cut and the tops of the timber cut is \$5,392.81. The court costs amounting to \$313.10; the taxes and interest to be paid to Dr. W. C. Holmes in the amount of \$275.86; and the attorney's fee for complainant's attorney amounting to \$888.56, make the total sum of \$1,477.52, which is a common charge against all of the parties to this proceeding, except Dr. W. C. Holmes. When the said sum of \$1,477.52 is deducted from the sum of \$5,392.81, it leaves a net balance for distribution to the complainant and the respondents, except Dr. W. C. Holmes, of the sum of \$3,915.29.

H. The sum of \$5,392.81, which represents the gross proceeds of the said sale and the timber cut and the tops of the timber, is now in possession of Alice J. Duck, as Register and Commissioner (except the amount of \$5,86.55, which is to be paid to her by Dr. W. C. Holmes, as hereinafter provided), and this amount should be distributed in the manner provided for in this decree and this cause finally settled.

Upon consideration of all of which, it is, therefore,, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court as follows:

- l. Alice J. Duck, as Register and Commissioner, is hereby authorized, empowered, instructed and directed to pay to herself, as Register, the sum of \$313.10, which amount is all of the court costs incurred in this proceeding, including an abstract bill of \$100.00. Alice J. Duck, as Register, is hereby authorized, empowered, instructed and directed to pay to J. A. Ertzinger and Son the sum of \$100.00 for the said abstract and take its receipt therefor and file the said receipt in this cause.
- 2. Alice J. Duck, as Register and Commissioner afore-said, is authorized, empowered and instructed to pay to Dr. W. C. Holmes the sum of \$275.86 to reimburse him for the taxes paid on the property involved in this proceeding, which amount includes interest in the amount of \$110.13.

- 3. The sum of \$888.56 shall be and it is hereby fixed and allowed to James R. Owen, as solicitor for the complainant, for services rendered by him as solicitor for the complainant in this cause, and the Register is hereby authorized, empowered, instructed and directed to pay to James R. Owen the said sum of \$888.56, take his receipt therefor and file it in this cause.
- 4. Dr. W. C. Holmes is hereby ordered to pay to Alice J. Duck, as Register and Commissioner, the sum of \$586.55 and this amount shall be a judgment against the said Dr. W. C. Holmes, for which execution may issue.
- 5. After the said amount in Paragraph 4 has been paid to Alice J. Duck, as Register and Commissioner, she will have in her possession for distribution to the parties hereto (except Dr. W. C. Holmes) the sum of \$3,915.29, which shall be distributed as follows:
