That Emmett Gulledge was duly appointed as administrator of the Estate of Viola Wright, Deceased, by the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, on December 16, 1955; that the administrator duly qualified as such and entered into a surety bond which has been approved by the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); that the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, acting by and through Walter Lindsey, as its attorney-in-fact, is the surety on such bond.

THIRD:

Your petitioner further shows unto this Court that the administration of said Estate was duly transferred from the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Equity, by an order duly entered by the Court on the ______ day of March, 1956, upon petition filed by Emmett Gulledge as administrator of said Estate and that the administration of said Estate is now pending in this Court.

FOURTH:

Your petitioner further shows unto your Honor that the said Viola Wright was killed in an automobile accident on December 3, 1955, as a result of the negligence of Frank J. Horak, jointly, have offered your petitioner in settlement of his claim for damages as such administrator, the sum of Four Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$4,100.00), the remaining part of the insurance coverage and the remaining part of a Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) contribution to be made by Frank J. Horak has been offered to the administrator of the Estate of the other deceased person and to the injured parties. In the opinion of your petitioner, it is to the best interest of said Estate for him to settle his claim for damages as such administrator for the sum of Four Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$4,100.00), as your petitioner believes that very little, if any more than this could be secured by him after litigation of the matter.

SIXTH:

Your petitioner further shows unto your Honor that the following named persons are all of the heirs at law and next of kin of such decedent, viz:

petitioner has received an offer of an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and such settlement is now to be in the sum of Four Thousnad One Hundred Dollars (\$4,100.00) That in and by the terms of the instrument which was signed by all of the heirs at law and next of kin of said decedent, they waive notice of the filing of this petition and notice of the day set for hearing the same and they consented to the granting of such petition without further notice to them and they agreed that it is to the best interest of such Estate for this Court to grant this petition.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that your Honor will enter an order and decree without notice to the heirs at law and next of kin of said decedent, granting this petition and authorizing the said Emmett Gulledge as administrator of the Estate of Viola Wright, Deceased, to settle all claims for damages which the Estate of Viola Wright, Deceased, has against Frank J. Your petitioner further prays that this Court will authorize and direct him to pay One Thousand Twenty-five Dollars (\$1,025.00) or one-fourth of the amount that he received, to Chason & Stone as attorneys for said Estate for handling such matter and representing this Estate. That the remaining Three Thousand Seventy-five Dollars (\$3,075.00) shall be held by your petitioner until a proper time for payment of costs of administration and for distribution to the heirs at law and next of kin of such decedent. Your petitioner further prays that your Honor will direct him as such administrator to enter into an additional surety bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), making a total bond of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), which bond shall be executed and filed with this Court before your petitioner receives any money in settlement of the matters hereinabove referred to.

Your petitioner prays for such other and further orders and decrees which would seem just and meet and to which he may be entitled in the premises.
