This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said

H. N. White Jr. is forever divorced from the said Fannie A. White for and on account of Abandonment.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That the Respondent shall have the care custody and control of the said child, Peggy White, age 16 years.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That the said, Complainant, H. N. White, Jr., shall pay to the Respondent, Fannie A. White, the sum of Fifty(\$50.00) Dollars per month as maintenance and support for said child.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that H. N. White, Jr. the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

White. doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is H. N. White, Jr., I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama have been more than one year next preceeding. The Respondent is over the age of 21 and is presently a resident of Pensacola, Florida. We were married at Pensacola, Florida on November 4, 1934 and lived together as husband and wife until our separation in Baldwin County on or about July 16, 1954. The Respondent voluntarily abandoned your Complainant at that time and we have not lived together as husband and wife since that time. There was born as fruits of our marriage 3 children one of whom is married, one in the Navy and the other being Peggy White a girl age about 16 years. There is no property to be divided. Your Complainant agrees to support the said child, Peggy White and during the time she may be residing with her mother to provide a sum equal to \$50.00 a month as maintenance and support for the said child. Your Complainant respectfully ask for a divorce as the parties to this cause will not live together anymore as husband and wife.

That my name is Mrs. Addie E. White, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and the Complainant is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. The Respondent is a resident of Pensacola, Florida. They were married at Pensacola, Florida on November 4, 1934 and lived together as husband and wife until their separation in Baldwin County, Alabama on or about July 16, 1954. They have not lived together as husband and wife since that time and I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife. There were born as fruits of this marriage three children, one of whom is married while the boy is still in service and the youngest child Peggy White being now age 16 years of age. I feel that the sum of \$50.00 a month is a reasonable sum for the maintenance and support of this child.

The Respondent admits the allegations as to ages, marriage and residence, but denies all other allegations contained in the bill of complaint, and demands strict proof of the same.

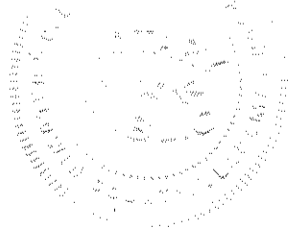

3.


